- Students are encouraged to take the GSC 385 section of Management Information Systems
- Seniors (whether entering the MAcc or not) with a GPA of 3.3 or better and who will meet BSBA graduation requirements are permitted to take one or two MAcc classes during their last undergraduate semester.
- Seniors are permitted to take Governmental and Not-for-Profit Accounting (MAcc 658) and include the 3 credits as part of the undergraduate program. Permission of Department Chair is required.
- Students who are not entering the MAcc, but plan to take the CPA exam, may take MAcc 658 as part of the undergraduate program and, if meeting an overall and Accounting GPA of 3.3, may take one or two of the following courses: Seminar in Taxation (MAcc 650) and either Business Law (PMBA 8491) or Auditing (MAcc 662).
- Completion of engaged learning points (6) is part of the graduation requirements for students entering Rider University in fall 2017 or later, including transfer students. Transfer students with 31 or more credits only need 3 points. Refer to each individual student's DegreeWorks for details.
