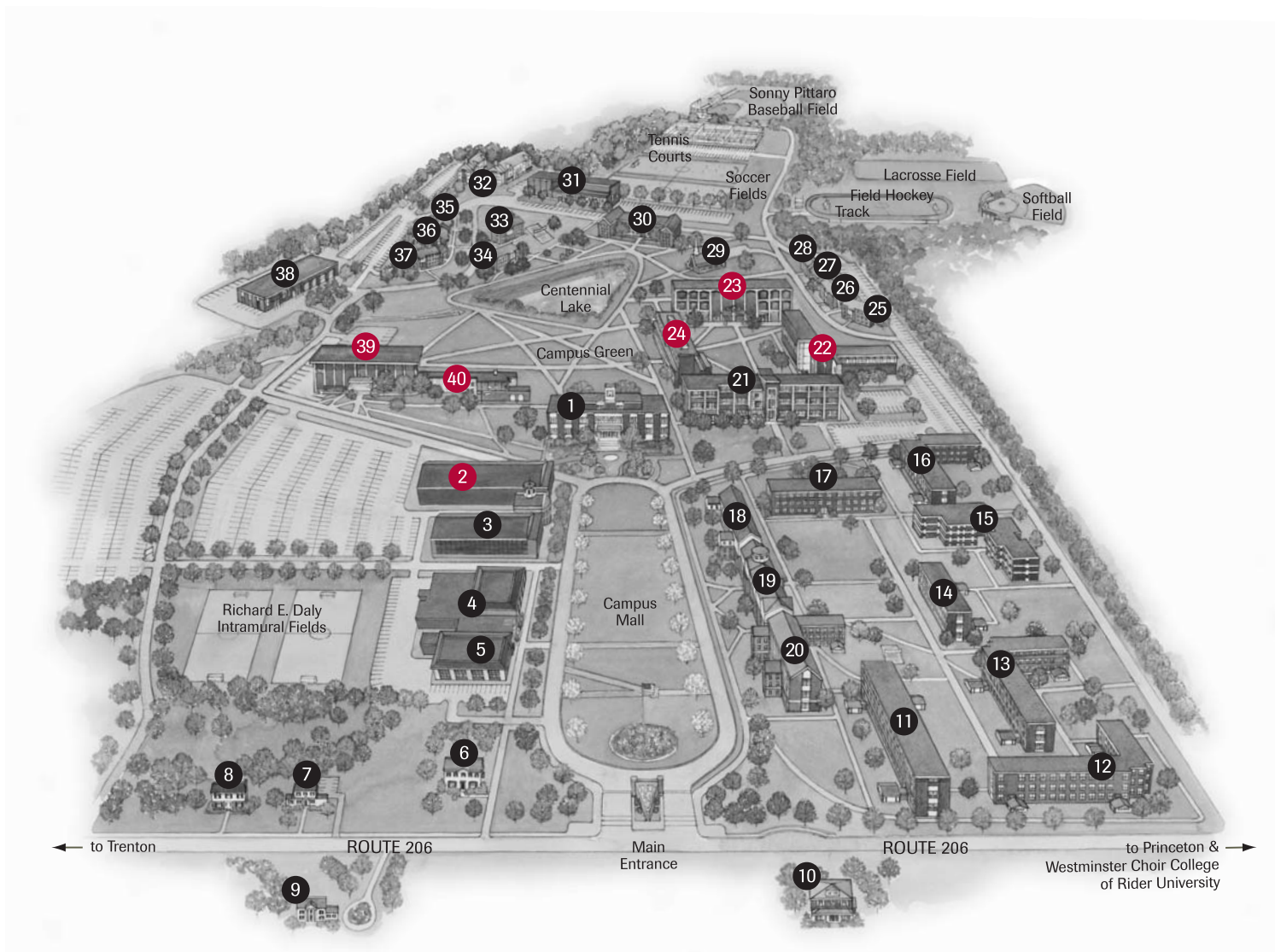
This two-person show of paintings and drawings by husband and wife Charles Cajori and Barbara Grossman explores opposing ways to approach the drawing and painting of the figure.
