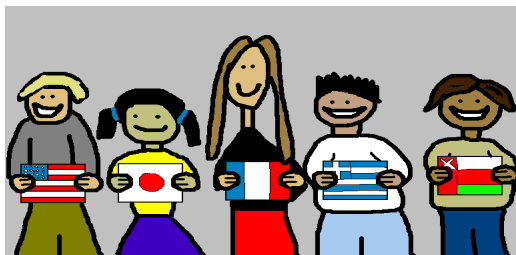


Application International Student Mentors SPRING 2009

- Good disciplinary record with Community Standards

Responsibilities:
