

2007-2008 Academic Catalog Addendum

We are pleased to announce the addition of two new courses since the publication of the 2007-2008 Academic Catalog. These electives are associated with the Center for Business Forensics programs.

CIS-309: *Data Structures and Computer Architecture:* Introduction to linked lists, stacks, queues, trees, pointers, and sorting and searching algorithms. Students will learn the technical details of data storage and manipulation along with the concepts of program execution, and will use tools such as hex-editors and debuggers. Pre-requisite is CIS-185 or permission of the instructor.

CIS-319: *Digital Forensics:* Students will use computers to obtain and analyze evidence found on storage devices such as those confiscated under warrant, and learn how to trace digital activities. Crime and investigative procedures will be explored in depth. Pre-requisite is CIS-309.
