

## Notice from the Office of Community Standards

March 16, 2009

Dear Members of the Rider Community,

The Student Senate Council recently approved a modification to the University Policy on smoking. Please note the following modifications which are effective immediately:

### **Page 42, Section D.2.**

In compliance with University policy and New Jersey State Law, smoking or the ignition of any tobacco product is prohibited in all buildings on campus. In addition, smoking is prohibited within 25 feet of all building entrances, within 25 feet of operable first floor windows, and within 25 feet of any building louvers or grilles providing outside air intake for equipment.

### **Page 81, 5.5 Smoking Policy**

In compliance with both University policy and New Jersey State law (N.J.S.A 26:3D-17), smoking or ignition of any tobacco or other product or substance is prohibited in all buildings on campus, including but not limited to classroom buildings, administrative office buildings, the Bart Luedeke Student Center (including the Pub), dining facilities, residence halls and Greek houses. In addition, smoking is prohibited within 25 feet of all building entrances, within 25 feet of operable first floor windows, and within 25 feet of any building louvers or grilles providing outside air intake for equipment. *Students are responsible for assuring that their guests comply with this policy in accordance with Rider University's guest policy.* (Consequences may range from levels 2 to 4)

### **Page 93, Campus Smoking Policy**

Rider University subscribes to a smoke-free work and study environment. In compliance with both University policy and New Jersey State law (N.J.S.S. 26:3D-17), smoking or ignition of any tobacco or other product or substance is prohibited in all buildings on campus, including but not limited to classroom buildings, administrative office buildings, the Bart Luedeke Student Center (including the Pub), dining facilities, residence halls and Greek houses. In addition, smoking is prohibited within 25 feet of all building entrances, within 25 feet of operable first floor windows, and within 25 feet of any building louvers or grilles providing outside air intake for equipment.
