

**STUDY, WORK & TRAVEL COURSE
IN
FUZHOU, CHINA
JUNE 27 - JULY 23, 2007**

Rider University is offering a one-week Chinese language/culture course to be followed by a two-week internship in which Rider students will work as English conversation tutors for Chinese secondary students (grades 7-12).

This three-credit course, offered in Summer II as

IND 210: GLOBAL ENCOUNTERS:
CULTURAL IMMERSION AND TUTORING IN CHINA

The cost of the program is \$3,895. The program fee includes:

- tuition for three credits
- round-trip airfare
- pre-departure orientation
- 2-day orientation and tour of Beijing, including the Forbidden City and the Great Wall
- 1-week language and cultural immersion course
- afternoon and weekend excursions, cultural events, outdoor activities and visits to local families
- 2 day/1 night excursion to the coastal and historic city, Xiamen
- room and board

Students will be provided with a stipend of approximately \$130 for their tutoring services. Admitted students may apply for program subsidies of \$250 or more. Applications for this program are available in the Office of International Programs (Contact Director Joe MacAde in BLC Room 112). Financial aid is also available for taking this course.
