Delete the word **Name** and center your first and last name at the top of your Resume. Please enter your current title and rank, department, and specialty, as well as office location, telephone and e-mail address.

2. Academic Background

List your degrees by date, with most recent first, title and college or university.

3. Work Experience

List your work experiences by date, with most recent first, position held, and school, university or employer.

4. Selected Publications

List selected publications by date, with most recent first, title, and publisher. It is suggested that you list only publications that have occurred within the last 10 years.

5. Selected Presentations

List selected presentations by date, with most recent first, title, and location/organization. It is suggested that you list only presentations that have been given within the last 10 years.

6. Current Research Agenda

Give a concise description of your ongoing and future research.

7. Academic Honors and Awards

List your academic honors and awards by date and description

8. Other Professional Activities

List your other professional activities by date and description

9. Courses Taught

List courses you have taught within the past five years by date, course name, and course number (SEC 400, etc.)
