RESOLUTION

Bicycle Identification and Security.

- Whereas many students on the Princeton campus would like to utilize the bicycle racks in the breezeways between Dayton, Ithaca, and Princeton Halls (the "DIPs");
- Whereas some bicycles locked on campus bicycle racks have not been unlocked or used in over two years and may not even belong to current University students: Now, therefore, be it

Resolved, that

- 1 The Students request the Dean of Students Office,
- 2 in conjunction with the Facilities Department and
- 3 the office of Safety and Security, to require all
- 4 bicycles stored and/or locked on the Princeton
- 5 campus during one properly announced week each
- 6 semester to be tagged with the University
- 7 member's name, phone number, and address. The
- 8 Students then request the aforementioned offices

- 9 to cut the locks off all bicycles locked on campus
- 10 racks that do not bear proper identification tags.
- 11 All unidentified bicycles should be taken into the
- 12 University's custody and donated to good will if
- 13 not claimed within one to two weeks.
