1	Whereas four monumental outdoor steel works by modernist sculptor
2	Isaac Witkin were installed on both campuses this year including
3	one prominently on display on the main drive in front of
4	Williamson Hall. This sculpture, Taurus, was created in 1975. All
5	six of the Witkin works on long-term loan to Rider University
6	came directly from the artist's private collection and had been
7	exhibited on his 23-acre blueberry farm in Pemberton, N.J., prior
8	to his sudden and untimely death in 2006.
9	Whereas no students or faculty members of Westminster Choir College
10	were ever consulted on the project;
11	Whereas the sculpture has no direct correlation to any academic or
12	student programs on the campus of Westminster Choir College;
13	Now, therefore be it
