

Visitor Guidelines

The best way to experience what it's like to be a Rider Bronc is to visit campus. To ensure the health and safety of the Rider community and our visitors, we are following a set of guidelines based on public health directives from the state of New Jersey and the CDC.

PRIOR TO YOUR VISIT

We are requiring all visitors to register in advance for an on-campus visit. To register, please visit rider.edu/visit. To maintain social distancing protocols, we will be **limiting all families to three visitors**: one prospective student and two guests.

ASSESS YOURSELF FOR SYMPTOMS

We ask you perform a COVID-19 symptom assessment before arriving to campus. If you feel sick or have been in contact with someone who has contracted COVID-19, please refrain from visiting campus. We can always reschedule your visit for a later date.

FACE COVERINGS

You and your guests are **required to bring a face covering** to wear when visiting campus. These should be worn indoors regardless of vaccination status. Face coverings should cover both your nose and mouth, including

masks without an exhalation valve and face shields. Additionally, we will have Rider face masks available to all guests.

And while we're excited to meet you in person, our admission staff and students will not be shaking hands out of an abundance of caution.

DAY OF YOUR VISIT

While Rider University is taking all precautions to safeguard our community, we cannot eliminate the risk of COVID-19 exposure and infection on campus. Please be reminded that you are undertaking your visit at your own risk. **If any visitor shows symptoms and tests positive for COVID-19 within 48 hours of visiting campus**, please report that information to the Office of Public Safety at 609-896-5029.
