

Visitor Guidelines

After months of careful planning, we're excited to be able to start in-person campus tours again. Truly, the best way to experience what it's like to be a Rider Bronc is to visit for a tour. To ensure the health and safety of the Rider community and our visitors, we are following a set of guidelines based on public health directives from the state of New Jersey and the CDC.

PRIOR TO YOUR VISIT

We are requiring all visitors to register in advance for an on-campus tour. To register, please visit [rider.edu/visit](https://www.rider.edu/visit). To maintain social distancing protocols, we will be **limiting all families to three visitors**: one prospective student and two guests.

ASSESS YOURSELF FOR SYMPTOMS

We ask you perform a COVID-19 symptom assessment before arriving to campus. If you feel sick or have been in contact with someone who has contracted COVID-19, please refrain from visiting campus. We can always reschedule your visit for a later date.

FACE COVERINGS AND HYGIENE

You and your guests are **required to bring a face covering** to wear when visiting campus. These should be worn at all times, especially when physical distancing of six feet or greater is not possible. Face coverings should cover both your nose and mouth, including masks without an exhalation valve and face shields. Additionally, we will have Rider face masks available to all guests.

The restroom on the ground floor of the Bart Luedeke Center will be available for use. We strongly encourage you to wash your hands with soap and water for 20 seconds, or use hand sanitizer.

And while we're excited to meet you in person, our admission staff and students will not be shaking hands out of an abundance of caution.

DAY OF YOUR VISIT

You will receive a link to check-in via text message an hour before your scheduled tour. When you arrive on campus, click on the link to check-in. Upon meeting your tour guide, you and your guests will be required to sign a waiver. Please note, if you arrive more than 10 minutes after your scheduled tour time, we cannot guarantee you will receive a full campus tour led by a tour guide.

Unfortunately, residence halls and Daly Dining Hall will be off-limits to tour guests at this time. We will be unable to provide in-person admission presentations, interviews or meetings. Instead, after the tour, you will receive your Admission Counselor's contact information to schedule a phone call or Zoom meeting.

While Rider University is taking all precautions to safeguard our community, we cannot eliminate the risk of COVID-19 exposure and infection on campus. Please be reminded that you are undertaking your visit at your own risk. **If any visitor shows symptoms and tests positive for COVID-19 within 48 hours of visiting campus**, please report that information to the Office of Public Safety at 609-896-5029.
