### About Katherine Mortimer

#### A Former Marine Pursues Her Calling in Education

Dr. Katherine E. Mortimer joined the United States Marine Corps in 1975, at a time when very few women served. Receiving promotions during her tenure in the Marines, eventually becoming Staff Sergeant, Mortimer attended college at night at every opportunity. During her transition to civilian life ten years later, she worked to support herself and her family and, again, sought to continue her college education. It was a challenge to return to college full-time as a single mother with two small children. At the time, the military did not provide education assistance to veterans. Mortimer says that being the recipient of a Charlotte W. Newcombe Foundation Scholarship\* had a profound impact on her life.

#### **Professional and Educational Success**

Mortimer earned her Bachelor of Science in Business Education at Rider in 1992, Summa Cum Laude. While working at a large public secondary school district, Mortimer went on to complete her Master of Science degree with honors in Organizational Dynamics at the University of Pennsylvania. She was promoted to a department coordinator in her school district and subsequently went on to complete her Doctorate in Education at Nova Southeastern University with a focus on Leadership, Curriculum and Educational Technology. Thereafter, she advanced in administrative positions demonstrating leadership throughout her school district.
