



**Advanced Program
Completion Rates and Average Completion Time**

Students enrolled in Advanced Programs must complete their program within six years of the enrollment date of the first course (with the exception of the Ed.S. in School Psychology, which is 10 years from the date of acceptance into the program). The data below has been calculated from the last three graduation cycles and shows the number of students that graduated within the given 6 years or 10 years for students in the School Psychology program.
