For transfer credit RVCC students must have a grade of "C" or better. (No transfer credit will be accepted for any course with a grade of "C-" or lower.)

- -RVCC students must have a grade of C+ or higher in all Education courses for transfer. (No transfer credit will be accepted with a grade of C- or below)
- $\infty$  The RVCC student may select a minor in Early Childhood Education, Special Education, ESL and Middle School and this is completed by working with the Education Academic Advisor to determine the courses needed and the course sequence that counts toward the degree.
- -Education students are required to earn a GPA of 3.00+prior to student teaching.
- -As of September 1, 2015, the New Jersey Department of Education requires all students to take and pass all sections of the Praxis The Core Academic Skills for Educators Test (Test Code: 5751) prior to formal entry into a teacher's preparation program.
