- Honors . Students should check with their intended transfer school for specific math requirements.
- ² Select a course from the appropriate category of the <u>General Education</u> list.
- ³ Mathematics by official placement. Students are advised to select from the following courses: MATH 111 Statistics II, MATH 112 Precalculus I, MATH 113 Precalculus II, MATH 114H Precalculus Honors, MATH 117H Statistics Honors, MATH 151 Calculus I. See transfer college requirements for math.
