3 Math Proficiency: Students must meet a minimum math proficiency of [MATH 030 Intermediate Algebra](#) to register for [MATH 110 Statistics I](#) . Students wishing to apply to the nursing program must meet a minimum math proficiency of [MATH 020 Elementary Algebra](#) .

It is recommended that students pursuing the nursing program come to a Nursing Information Session and complete the ATI TEAS test no later than the end of the second semester, prior to any application deadlines.
