

SUPERVISED STUDY

OVERVIEW: A supervised study is an independent learning experience in which faculty and the student work out a plan to cover the course materials in a mutually agreeable manner. It can be viewed as a "tutorial" for the student with the guidance from the faculty member. <u>Juniors, Seniors, and Graduates</u> in good academic standing who, for reasons beyond their control, find that a required course has not been scheduled before they expect to graduate may receive permission from a faculty sponsor, the department chair, and the Dean to register NO LATER THAN THE LAST DAY TO ADD COURSES FOR THE SEMESTER IN WHICH THE SUPERVISED STUDY IS TO BE UNDERTAKEN.

INSTRUCTIONS: This form must be completed and accompanied with course syllabus before submitting to the Dean's Office. Once all signatures have been received, submit form to the Registrar's Office.
