Overnight Flight → 1 night

Day 1: Travel day

Board your overnight flight to Milan today.

Milan \rightarrow 4 nights

Day 2: Arrival in Milan

Included meals: welcome dinner
Welcome to Italy! Meet your Tour Director and
fellow travelers at a welcome dinner this evening.

Day 3: Sightseeing tour of Milan

Included meals: breakfast

Meet up with a local guide and embark on a sightseeing tour of Italy's fashion capital.

- · Pass by the 15th-century Sforza Castle
- Walk through the Brera District and see the statue of Leonardo da Vinci, the Galleria Vittorio Emanuele, and Piazza della Scala
- Enter Teatro alla Scala and view the elegant concert hall
- Visit the theater's museum to see exhibits that highlight Italy's historic connection to the opera
- Step inside the Gothic-style Milan Cathedral, Italy's largest cathedral

Please note: If there is a show or practice in session, travelers will not enter the concert hall. Enjoy a free afternoon to explore Milan at your leisure.

Day 4: Lake Como boat ride & Bellagio

Included meals: breakfast, lunch
Head out on a morning trip to explore Como, a
city known for its mix of cultural and natural
attractions.

- Enjoy free time in Como for lunch and shopping, while admiring the lakeside vistas
- Hop aboard a scenic cruise of Lake Como to soak in some of Italy's most beautiful estates and gardens
- Float past charming small towns to Bellagio, a village whose scenery has inspired poets and young lovers for centuries
- Take in Bellagio's classic beauty before heading to a local restaurant, where you'll sit down for an included lunch

Day 5: La Morra & Barolo

Included meals: breakfast, light lunch, wine tasting

Visit the village of La Morra for a panoramic view of the Langhe, the hilly Piedmont region famous for its cheeses, truffles, and wines. While here, you'll enter the UNESCO-recognized Castle of Grinzane Cavour.

Then, visit Barolo, a small town with one of the most well-known names in Northern Italian wine.

- Enjoy a light lunch of local specialties at a winery
- Sample local Barolo vintages in the vineyard's wine cellar

Bologna → 2 nights

Day 6: Bologna via Cremona & cooking class

Included meals: breakfast, tasting, dinner
As you head to Bologna, stop for a guided tour
of the Violin Museum in Cremona which houses
some of Antonio Stradivari's famous stringed
violins and cellos alongside other instruments.
Then, continue on to Bologna for a hands-on
evening. Learn how to make tortellini, tortelloni,
and tagliatelle during a cooking class. Then,
enjoy eating the meal you've prepared for dinner.

Day 7: Food of Bologna walking tour

Included meals: breakfast, tasting
This morning, venture out on a food themed
walking tour of Bologna with a local guide.

- Peruse the local fish and vegetable market district and explore Piazza Maggiore
- Make your way to Mercato delle Erbe to sample traditional Bolognese foods like olive oil, cured meats, and cheese
- Head to Quadrilatero, the city's oldest food market, and learn about the culture behind the area's food as you stop at various shops along the way

Italian Riviera → 2 nights

Day 8: Italian Riviera via Parma

Included meals: breakfast, lunch, tasting
As you head to the seaside paradise that is the
Italian Riviera, stop to try some culinary delights.

- Visit a local Parmigiano Reggiano producer and enjoy a cheese tasting
- Tour a family-run balsamic vinegar villa and discover how they produce their high-end, aged balsamic known as Aceto Balsamico Tradizionale di Modena
- Try the balsamic vinegar during a lunch featuring a variety of appetizers, a risotto dish, and a buffet of desserts

Then, continue on to the Italian Riviera and enjoy a free evening.

Day 9: Sightseeing tour of Cinque Terre

Included meals: breakfast

Join your Tour Director to discover Cinque Terre, an idyllic cluster of five villages set on seaside cliffs

- Board a train to Vernazza and admire the colorful houses that dot the waterfront
- Continue by train to the dramatic coastal village of Riomaggiore
- Enjoy a scenic boat ride to Monterosso and soak in views of the pebble beach that the village is known for
- Learn about Via dell'Amore, one of the area's most famous hiking paths, which connects two of the five villages
- Enjoy short walks through each village before spending free time exploring, shopping, and eating
- Admire the Liguria regions' varied landscape as you transfer back to your hotel by train

Please note: The boat ride is weather-dependent. In the case of inclement weather, you'll visit the villages by train. In addition, the specific villages you visit may vary.

Florence → 2 nights

Day 11: Transfer to Florence & sightseeing tour

Included meals: breakfast

Cross through the Apennine Mountains as you make your way to Florence. Once you arrive, get to know the city with a local guide.

- View the legendary Florence Cathedral, known as the Duomo
- Pass Giotto's Campanile, a masterpiece of Gothic architecture
- Walk past Piazza della Repubblica to the medieval Ponte Vecchio
- Stroll along the Arno River and through the courtyard of the Uffizi Gallery to Piazza della Signoria, center of Florentine life Sit down for an included dinner this evening.

Day 12: Galleria dell'Accademia & Fiesole villa farewell dinner

Included meals: breakfast, farewell dinner
This morning join a local guide for a tour of the
Galleria dell'Accademia as you learn about
Renaissance art history and view a variety of
pieces, including the marble statue of David.
Head just outside Florence to Fiesole, a historic
Tuscan town perched on a hill overlooking the
Renaissance city. Tonight's farewell dinner is set
in a picturesque villa with panoramic views of the
city below. Start your evening with an aperitif
and then enjoy a refined Italian dinner with local
wine to celebrate your trip.

Flight Home

Day 13: Departure

Included meals: breakfast (excluding early morning departures)

Transfer to the airport for your flight home or extend your stay to explore Venice.

Day 13: Train ride to Venice

Included meals: breakfast, light lunch, wine tasting

This morning, climb aboard a high-speed train and take off across the Italian countryside to Venice. Upon arrival, take a water taxi ride to your hotel.

Day 14: Sightseeing tour of Venice

Included meals: breakfast

Admire historic churches, winding canals, and picture-perfect piazzas on a guided tour of the city known as the Queen of the Adriatic.

- Step into the iconic St. Mark's Square and enter St. Mark's Basilica
- View the stately Doge's Palace, built in the Venetian Gothic style in 1340
- Marvel at the Bridge of Sighs, the link between Doge's Palace and the New Prison

Day 10: Villages of the Italian Riviera & Lunch

\$105/\$115* (7.5 hours, departs in the morning, lunch included)

Drive through the countryside to Sestri Levante, a beautiful seaside village located on the Italian Riviera. Here, you'll have free time to explore on your own before setting out on a walk along the coastline to Baia delle Silenzio, one of the city's sparkling azure bays. Enjoy stunning bayside views while eating a delicious lunch of local seafood and meat specialties paired with regional wine. Then, stroll through the village castle gardens and take in views of both Baia delle Silenzio and another bay known as Baia delle Favole. Next, hop aboard a ferry to make your way to the breathtaking village of Portofino. Artists and celebrities alike flock to this celebrated destination, and you'll enjoy free time for shopping or relaxing while admiring the picturesque vistas of the harbor. Please note: This excursion is seasonal and runs from March through November. It also involves a moderate amount of walking.

Day 14: The Island of Murano

The Venetian island of Murano is world famous for its glass-blowing and their master artisans handcrafting each piece into a true pieces of art and have honed their skills for over a thousand years. On this excursion you'll take a boat ride to this charming island and step inside a glassblowing workshop for a demonstration to see how the artists craft delicate shapes and forms from molten class. Afterwards, enjoy free time to shop and explore the island.

Day 15: Islands of the Venetian Lagoon: Burano & Torcello

\$75/\$85* (5 hours, departure time varies)
Visit the islands of the Venetian lagoon, a favorite day
trip for locals and travelers alike. First travel by water
taxi to Torcello, where the story of Venice began. It was
here that mainlanders sought a safe haven from
invading barbarians. Step inside the Basilica of Santa
Maria Assunta, whose famous mosaics depict The Last
Judgement. The next stop is the tiny fishing village of
Burano, where brightly colored homes greet visitors.
Wander as you please throughout Burano, and be sure
to stop in at the island's bakeries.
