REQUIREMENTS:

Candidates should be enrolled in and have taken a course in the Master's Program in Counseling with either a concentration in Clinical or School Counseling or the Organizational Leadership M.A program, or be enrolled in the Organizational Leadership M.A. program.

INFORMATION:

This is a 20-hour per week position with occasional evening/weekend programming (whatever days are worked the total work will be 20 hours per week). The hourly rate is \$14.22/hour. Additional compensation includes tuition remission for up to two courses.
