U – Students have a number of options to satisfy this requirement; courses will be evaluated on an individual basis.

For transfer credit the Mercer student must have a grade of “C” or higher in all courses for transfer credit. (No transfer credit will be accepted for any course with a grade of “C-” or below.)

For all Psychology courses, the Rider student must earn a grade of “C” or higher in all courses to count for the major.

The Guaranteed Transfer Admission Agreement between Mercer County Community College and Rider University is designed to allow students who complete their Associate’s degree at Mercer County Community College to transfer to a Bachelor’s degree program at Rider University.
