

2020 Senior Class Commencement Speaker

Application Process

Rider University has a long history of student speakers at Commencement and we look forward to another outstanding address from a member of the class of 2020. Seniors who would like to be considered as a candidate for the Class of 2020 Commencement Speaker must:

- Be eligible to participate in the commencement ceremonies on May 16, 2020
- Be in good academic, financial, and judicial standing
- Be able to speak effectively to a large audience

The application process and timeline is as follows:

Wednesday, February 5, 2020, 5 p.m., Shapiro Board Room, SRC (above Starbucks)

Due Monday, March 2, 2020: Applicants are required to submit the documents listed below via email to *deanofstudents@rider.edu*.

- 1. The full text of your speech. Your speech should be 5-7 minutes in length and should reflect the impact Rider University has had on you and a message you would like to leave with your class.
- 2. A copy of your resume that includes your name and contact information; major/minor; G.P.A.; information on any honors and or awards received; jobs, internships or co-ops; Rider University activities and offices held; Community Service activities; and the names of two (2) Rider University references.
- 3. A cover letter that describes your interest in being considered as a candidate for the Senior Class Speaker. Please also include a response to each of the following prompts. Your answers should not exceed one-paragraph per prompt.
 - What is your perception of the purpose of a commencement speech?
 - What do you think should be included in a commencement speech?
 - What are the reasons why you want to be considered as a candidate?
 - What is the most important way in which Rider has impacted your life?

Tuesday, March 3 - Wednesday, March 25, 2020

A committee composed of faculty, administrators and academic deans will select 5 to 7 finalists for further consideration. The finalists will be interviewed by the committee and asked to present their entire speech.

Thursday, March 26, 2020

The finalists will be informed of the committee's decision in writing. A Senior Class Commencement Speaker and an Alternate Speaker will be chosen.

The student selected will work closely with a committee member to prepare for his or her Commencement address.
