AUDITORS PLEASE NOTE:

- Traditional audit registrations are only accepted on the first day of class in a given session/semester. You may submit your application with your registration, or at any time prior to the first day of class.

- A course must have available (open) seats on the first day to be eligible for audit registration.

- Courses that may **not** be audited include: online courses, any applied course (such as studio art, piano, voice, speech, and all writing courses), any course requiring a lab, a course requiring the permission of an instructor, courses reserved for majors or other special learning communities, and courses relying heavily on group or team projects.

- Inform the instructor that you are auditing the course by the end of the first class period. Participation in course work is solely at the discretion of the instructor.
