



- 1. Remove the top of your pumpkin and clean out all the seeds and pulp.
- 2. Print out the template and trim around the artwork, leaving about 1/2" of space all the way around.
- 3. Tape the template to the pumpkin being careful not to crease the design.
- **4.** Using a thin, pointed tool such as a toothpick, poke holes around the black edges of the template about 1/s" apart. Make sure you are piercing through to the outer layer of pumpkin.
- **5.** Use a small, sharp knife to carve out the design, slowly working from one outline hole to the next. It may be easier to cut out smaller sections at a time.
- **6.** When you are finished carving the design, place a candle or battery powered light source inside the pumpkin, replace the top, and display.





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RIDER

- 1. Remove the top of your pumpkin and clean out all the seeds and pulp.
