Any college courses you complete while in high school may be eligible for college credit. **Credit evaluations will include only work that is recorded on official college transcripts**. Evaluations are conducted by the Dean's Office of the college to which you have been admitted. A final evaluation of your credits, including those completed during the current term, will be provided after an official final transcript is received by the Office of Admission.

**AP/IB Credit:** If you have taken Advanced Placement or International Baccalaureate exams, have those scores sent directly to Rider for evaluation. You'll find our AP/IB credit policy at **rider.edu/ap**.

#### **For Test Optional**

If you were admitted to Rider as a test-optional applicant, and you took the SAT or ACT test, you are strongly encouraged to send your scores to the Office of Admission by **Friday, May 15**.

The tuition deposit is **\$20** and the housing deposit is **\$20**.

# How to Submit Your Tuition & Housing Deposits

We offer two options for paying your tuition and housing deposits. **All deposits are non-refundable**. Please read all instructions carefully.

#### By Phone

To pay your deposit by phone with a credit card, call the Cashier's Office at **609-896-5390**.



# Attend Orientation and Complete Placement Testing

EOP placement testing and orientation takes place at the beginning of the Pre-Freshman Program in July. Visit **rider.edu/orientation** for details about placement testing requirements and exemptions.

## **Complete Your Financial Agreement**

The federal government requires that all students certify their understanding of the financial obligations associated with enrolling in college **before they can register for courses**. We've made the process easy. Simply log in to your **myRider** student portal to read and electronically sign your financial agreement.

## Register for Courses

You will register for courses during Orientation.

### Change Your Major

To change your program of study before you enroll, email a written request to **admissions@rider.edu**. Program changes are permitted only with Office of Admission approval.

## By Check or Money Order

Make your check or money order payable to Rider University. If you are a commuter, pay only the \$20 tuition deposit. If you plan to live on campus, send one check or money order in the amount of \$40 (to cover the \$20 tuition deposit and \$20 housing deposit).

Be sure to include your full name and Bronc ID (see the bottom of your acceptance letter) on your check or money order.
