Complete Your Financial Agreement

The federal government requires that all students certify their understanding of the financial obligations associated with enrolling in college **before they can register for courses**. Change Your Major

To change your program of study before you enroll, email a written request to **admissions@rider.edu**. Program changes are permitted only with Office of Admission approval.

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How to Submit Your Tuition & Housing Deposits

We offer several options for paying your tuition and housing deposits. **All deposits are non-refundable**. Please read all instructions carefully.

Online

To make your deposit online, you'll need to access your myRider portal at myRider.rider.edu.

Click the "Applicant" tab (next to the "Welcome" tab, top left).

Find the "Steps to enrolling at Rider" box and click "Pay my deposit."

Select the Fall 2020 term.

Choose "Fall – Tuition & Housing (\$400)" if you plan to live on campus OR "Fall – Tuition Only (\$200)" if you will commute.

Select "Make Deposit Payment" and payment method, then click "Continue."

You will receive a confirmation email once you click **"Submit Payment."**

The tuition deposit is \$200 and the housing deposit is \$200.

By Check or Money Order

Make your check or money order payable to Rider University. If you are a commuter, pay only the \$200 tuition deposit. If you plan to live on campus, send one check or money order in the amount of \$400 (to cover the \$200 tuition deposit and \$200 housing deposit).

Be sure to include your full name and Bronc ID (see the bottom of your acceptance letter) on your check or money order.
