Mercer County Community College Footnotes:

NOTE: Electives should be selected in consultation with an academic advisor in order to assume maximum transfer of credits.

1 – Select courses – other than any MAT (mathematics) course or ECO 103 – from at least two of the following general education categories: Social Science, Humanities, Historical Perspective, Diversity and Global Perspective.

2 – BUS 210, 218, 244 or MKT 101 are acceptable substitutes, provided BUS 230 is taken as one of the four general education electives. Select in consultation with an academic advisor in order to assure maximum transfer of credits.

3 - Consult academic advisor for credit transfer requirements.

† - HPE 111 is an acceptable alternative.

NOTE; Mathematics courses may not be selected as general education electives.

Rider University:

4 – Rider University brings in the fourth credit for Mercer – 4-credit courses in multiples of 3.
 HPE Requirement is waived at Mercer County Community College for this major.
 5 – Students have a number of options to satisfy this requirement; courses will be evaluated on an individual basis.
 For transfer credit the Mercer student must have a “C” or higher in all courses for transfer credit.
 Mercer students interested in the College of Continuing Studies (CCS) at Rider should contact that division directly.
