To make your deposit online, you'll need to access your myRider portal at myRider.rider.edu.

Click the "Applicant" tab (next to the "Welcome" tab, top left).

Find the **"Steps to enrolling at Rider"** box and click **"Pay my deposit."**

Select the **Spring 2020** term.

Choose "Spring – Tuition & Housing (\$400)" if you plan to live on campus OR "Spring – Tuition Only (\$200)" if you will commute.

Select "Make Deposit Payment" and payment method, then click "Continue."

You will receive a confirmation email once you click "Submit Payment."

By Check or Money Order

Make your check or money order payable to Rider University. If you are a commuter, pay only the \$200 tuition deposit. If you plan to live on campus, send one check or money order in the amount of \$400 (to cover the \$200 tuition deposit and \$200 housing deposit).

Be sure to include your full name and Bronc ID (see the bottom of your acceptance letter) on your check or money order.
