SENATE RESOLUTION

In the Senate of the Student Government of Westminster Choir College on the Princeton Campus of Rider University

Sen. Fili submitted the following resolution concerning the seating problem in the Dining Commons at Westminster Choir College

1	WHEREAS: Westminster Choir College has one dining hall in
2	service for the entire College community from the hours of
3	7:30AM to 6:30PM;
4	WHEREAS: The Dining Commons was not designed to service
5	the quantity of patrons it currently does;
6	WHEREAS: The Dinning Commons serves not only the students
7	on the College meal plan, but students, faculty and staff
8	who wish to purchase meals;
9	WHEREAS: The dining facilities are insufficient during times of
10	high volume;
11	
12	NOW THERFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:
13	It is the opinion of the student body as represented
14	by the Senate of the Student Government Association of
15	Westminster Choir College on the Princeton campus of
16	Rider University that the seating in the Dining Commons
17	needs to be expanded. This senate recommends to the
18	Department of University Facilities that the ledge
19	surrounding the front stairs to the Dining Commons be
20	converted into a raised seating area. This senate
21	recommends that the ledge be expanded to three feet wide.
22	The side facing the Dining Commons shall serve as a bar
23	style overhang, and raised chairs shall be placed there for
24	seating. On the opposite side, a six-inch high lip will guard
25	the staircase from anything that may fall. The senate
26	would like to see this renovation completed by the start of
27	the spring semester of 2008. This senate will be happy to

discuss our vision of this project in further detail if the
administration of Westminster Choir College, Rider
University, and the Department of University Facilities
would wish.
