 - a. As part of NASM draft facilities ADA compliance was questioned
 - b. Rider hired a firm to look at ADA building-by-building guidelines
 - c. Went to Trustees for three projects in February 2010:
 - i. Student Center Bathrooms
 - ii. Handicap Accessable Restroom in Bristol
 - iii. Work on the Quad Pavement to make it less uneven and more even, and the Leaning Wall of Pisa. These projects combined cost \$300,000.
