Mr. OLSON (with Mr. GOLDBERG) submitted the following bill; which
was considered and agreed to

A BILL

To create a Parking Committee.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate of the Student Government*

2 *Association of the Princeton Campus of Rider University assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1: SHORT TITLE**

4 SHORT TITLE.—This Act may be cited as the
5 “Parking Committee of the Princeton Campus of Rider
6 University Act.”

7 **SECTION 2: FINDINGS AND PURPOSE**

8 (1) FINDINGS.—The Senate finds the following:

9 (A) The Students of the Princeton Campus are
10 greatly concerned with the conditions of the parking
11 facilities.

12 (B) Actions need to be taken by the Students to
13 correct these problems in tandem with the University
14 Administration.

15 (C) Actions need to be with a broader understanding
16 of the possible impacts to the community of Westminster
17 Choir College.

18 (1) PURPOSE.—The purpose of this Act is to:

19 (A) Create a committee responsible for the
20 actions of researching and finding constructive answers to
21 the parking situations on the Princeton Campus of Rider
22 University.

23 **SECTION 3: CREATION OF THE SENATE ACTIVITIES**
24 **COMMITTEE**

25 (1) IN GENERAL.— The Senate of the Student
26 Government Association shall create the Parking
27 Committee to be chaired by a Senator and to be composed
28 of members from the Westminster community.

29 (A) The committee will be responsible for meeting
30 with the President’s Cabinet member for facilities, the
31 Westminster Conservatory, the Students, the
32 Administration of Rider University, Princeton Borough,
33 Princeton Township in an attempt to create effective and
34 realistic solutions to the current problems of parking on the
35 Princeton Campus.

36 (C) Committee creation will commence immediately
37 and will continue until the end of the Westminster Choir
38 College academic year or until all parking problems have
39 been resolved. Should this committee desire to continue
40 next year, its members must petition the Senate for
41 reinstatement in the subsequent academic year.

42 Reinstatement will not require a new Bill, but a simple
43 majority for reinstatement and a new chair appointed.

44 **SECTION 4: ENACTMENT**

45 The actions set forth in this Act shall commence on
46 November 9, 2005.
