The Philanthropic Educational Organization is an organization of women devoted to promoting women's education. The **Program for Continuing Education (PCE) Grant**, a <u>financial need-based grant</u>, provides up to \$3000 to women whose education has been interrupted, and who now would like to resume their studies.

A woman is eligible to apply if she meets the following requirements:

• Is a citizen of the US or Canada.

• Has experienced at least 24 consecutive months as a non-student at some time in her adult life.

- Is within 24 months of completing her educational goal.
- Is <u>not</u> enrolled in a doctoral degree program, e.g. educational, law, medical or clinical.

The **Program for Continuing Education (PCE) Grant** is a <u>need-based grant</u> for educational expenses only, including tuition, books, transportation, and childcare. **Applicants must be able to demonstrate financial need.**

Each candidate must be sponsored by a PEO chapter. Our PEO Chapters representatives will be happy to interview any woman interested in our grant.
