

Pumpkin Carving Stencil



Instructions

1. Remove the top of your pumpkin and clean out all the seeds and pulp.
2. Print out the template and trim around the artwork, leaving about ½" of space all the way around.
3. Tape the template to the pumpkin being careful not to crease the design.
4. Using a thin, pointed tool such as a toothpick, poke holes around the black edges of the template about ⅛" apart. Make sure you are piercing through to the outer layer of pumpkin.
5. Use a small, sharp knife to carve out the design, slowly working from one outline hole to the next. It may be easier to cut out smaller sections at a time.
6. When you are finished carving the design, place a candle or battery powered light source inside the pumpkin, replace the top, and display.

Instructions
