- As of September 1, 2015 The New Jersey Department of Education requires students to take and pass all sections of Praxis The Core Academic Skills for Educators Test (Test Code: 5751) prior to formal entry into a teacher preparation program.
- > For transfer the Brookdale student must earn a grade of C or higher in all courses.
