****Students selecting COMP 132 or COMP 171 as an elective are required to take COMP 126 as a prerequisite or corequisite.

(1) A minimum of 9 credits are required from the <u>Mathematics</u>, <u>Science</u> or <u>Technological Competency</u> categories.

(2) One course is recommended from the Cultural and Global Awareness knowledge area.

(3) Students are required to complete a minimum of 30 credits of General Education coursework.
