^β If CCM students take MAT-124-Statistics or MAT-130-Probability & Statistics it transfers to Rider as MSD-200-
Statistical Methods I. If MAT-126 -Advanced Statistics is taken in the second semester, it transfers to Rider as MSD-
201-Statistics II. Both then waive the need to take MSD-105-Quantitative Methods for Business at Rider.
