**Rider University Footnotes:**

- ∩ Students have a number of options to satisfy this requirement; courses will be evaluated on an individual basis.
- For transfer credit the Mercer student must have a grade of “C” or higher in all courses for transfer credit.  
 The curriculum is designed to provide a seamless transition from an Associate degree or diploma program, building on students’ experiences in allied health profession.  
 Separate clinicals are not required.  
 Mercer students should successfully complete the examination given by the American Society for Clinical Pathologists.  
 The Rider degree requires a total of 120 credits; the Mercer student may need to take additional credits to meet the Rider University degree.
