Rules & Regulations

We want to make sure your experience at Rider’s Summer Programs for High School and Middle School students is rewarding and fun. To ensure the safety of all our participants we ask that you abide by these rules:

- Per college policy, a \$50 fee will be charged for any unreturned residence hall keys.
- Smoking and the use of alcohol or illegal drugs are strictly forbidden.
- Any damage or loss of college property will be charged to the person(s) responsible.
- Parents and students are not allowed to disassemble any furniture in the rooms, or you will be charged to replace the furniture.
- Your room must be left in the state in which it was found, or you will be charged a \$50 cleaning fee.
- Students are only allowed off-campus during planned activities, always in groups accompanied by a counselor, faculty and/or staff. At no time are students permitted off campus without a counselor.
- ID badges must be worn at all times
- Students are expected to be in their respective residence halls at the designated curfew (normally 10:30 p.m.) and are expected to remain in their residence hall until 7:00 a.m. unless otherwise informed by the College of Continuing Studies or the head counselor.
- Attendance is required at all assigned classes and activities unless expressly excused by the College of Continuing Studies or the head counselor. If they miss any of their assigned classes without permission they will be given an earlier curfew or other penalty.
- Students are asked to limit the use of cell phones while they are at Rider. Cell phone use is prohibited when the student is in camp activities. If the student is found using the phone during the prohibited hours, the phone will be confiscated and returned to the student the next day.
